Motorcycles, which were first developed in the late 19th century, were a direct result of the invention of the internal combustion engine. The first commercial motorcycle was the Daimler Reitwagen, a three-wheeled, pedal-powered vehicle designed by Gottlieb Daimler and Wilhelm Maybach in 1884. It employed a horizontal single-cylinder engine mounted on a frame with two steerable front wheels and a rear wheel. By 1900 many motorcycles were being produced, as well as pedal cycles, as they were being improved by adding a centrally mounted engine. The need for a more powerful and efficient engine led to the road motorcycle trials and competition between manufacturers. The first Tourist Trophy motorcycle races were held in the Isle of Man in 1907 as endurance races. Such events have been the proving ground for many new designs from trials to turbocharged, multi-valve engines mounted on aerodynamic, frameless chassis.
